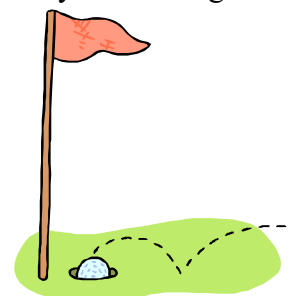
## 11<sup>th</sup> Annual Greater Cincinnati OSU Alumni Classic

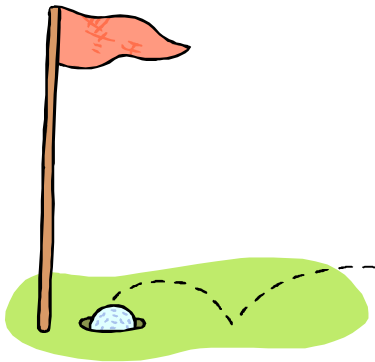

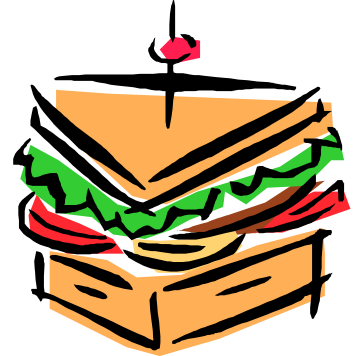
